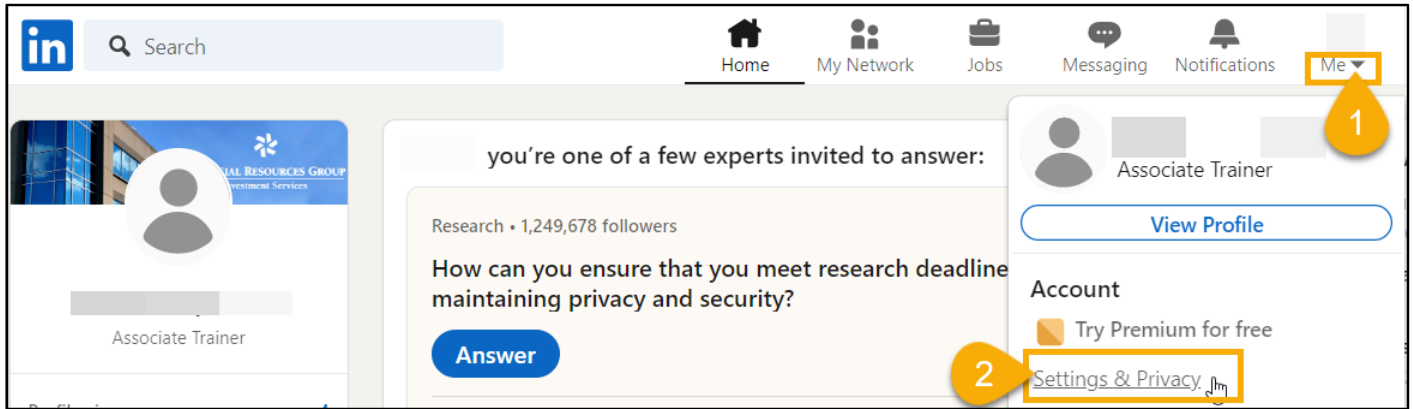


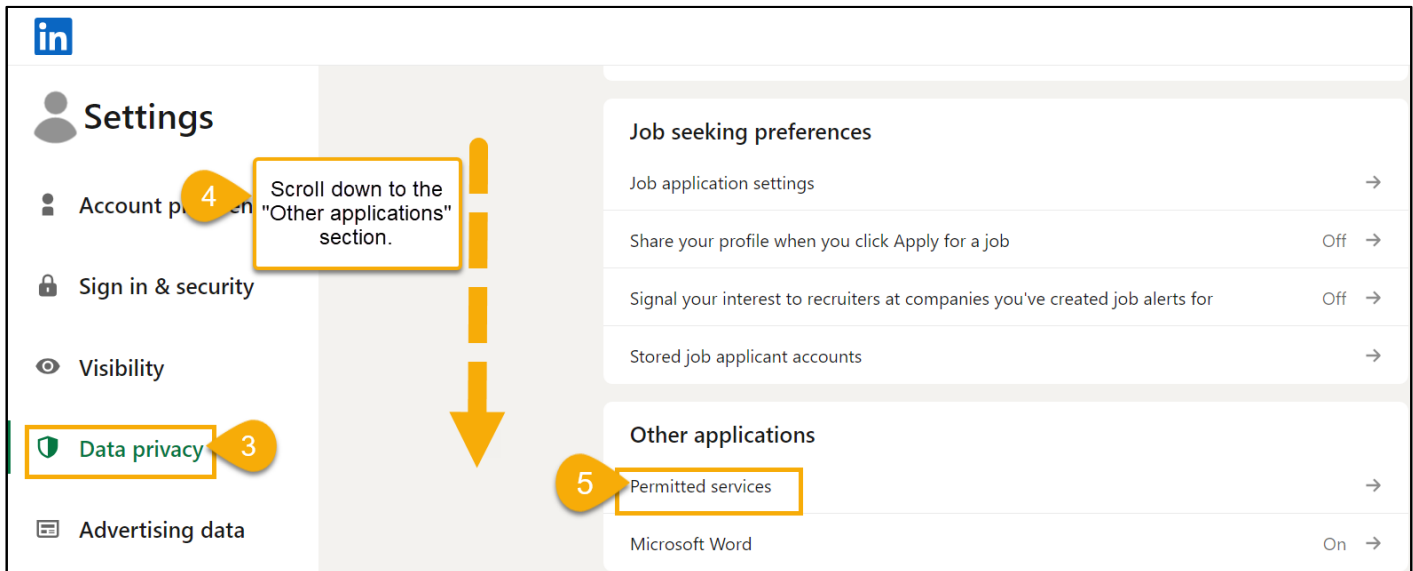
# Social Patrol: Checking Your LinkedIn Profile for Authorization

Sign into your LinkedIn profile to check if Social Patrol is authorized on your account. Follow these [5 quick steps](#) to verify access was granted.

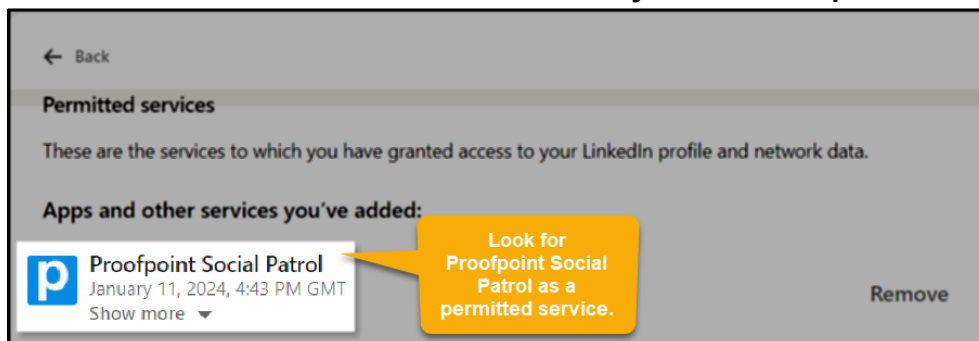
1. Click on “Me” under your profile picture on the top right corner of the page.

An example is shown below when Social Patrol is active on your LinkedIn profile.

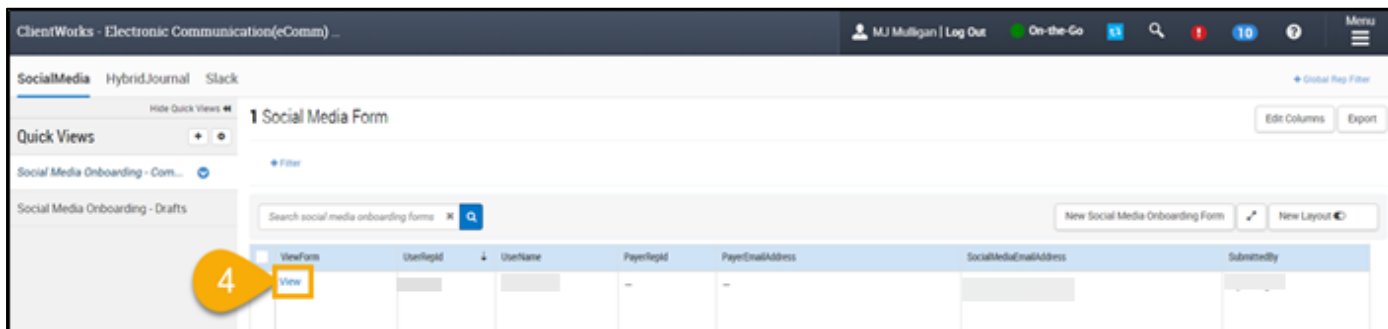
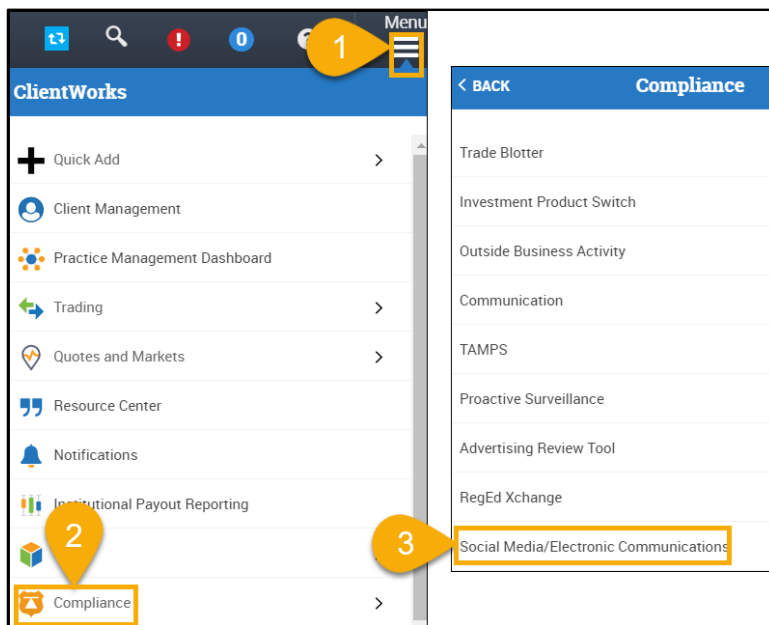


# ClientWorks:

## Checking for the Social Media Onboarding Form

Check ClientWorks for the completed Social Media Onboarding Form, or access the installation link to authorize / reauthorize Social Patrol on your Social Media account.

1. Click on Menu.
2. Then select "Compliance".
3. Select the "Social Media / Electronic Communications" option.
4. Click on "View" to see your Social Media Form if one was completed.
